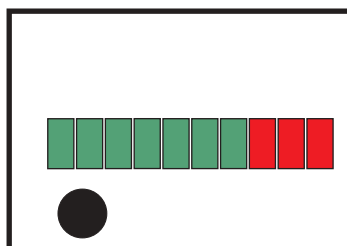

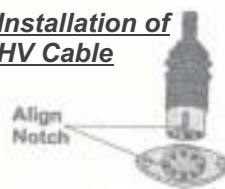

- 1- ON / OFF Button.
  - 2- Strap Adaptors.
  - 3- Belt Clip.
  - 4- Red Indicator Light - Lights During Recycling, Then Goes Off, As A LBW (Low Battery Warning) Light, OR Is A Short Circuit Protection Light.
  - 5- Green "Ready" Light - Lights When The Unit Is Ready, And Indicates 100% Recycle
  - 6- Battery Gauge. (See below)
  - 7- Check Button to Light The Battery Gauge.
  - 8- Charge Jack - Charger Connects Here.
  - 9- High Voltage Jack - Goes To The Flash With The Appropriate HV Cable For Each Flash.
- Arrow Aligns with Knotch On Connector. (see chart)**

- ### Important Notes:
- Some Flash Units require that the internal batteries be installed in order to operate properly. In some cases those batteries just have to be inside the unit. In other cases the batteries have to have a good charge.
  - If you are having problems ranging from no flash at all to only being able to shoot manual, don't forget to check the internal batteries.
  - When testing your flash unit it is easy to flash it in a manner far beyond normal use, Be Careful. All flash units have a "duty cycle" or limit to the amount of rapid fire use which they can handle.
  - The Cyclor can handle far more than any flash unit available. However, flashing rapidly, for extended periods of time can damage the flash unit. To avoid damaging your flash, test it only as you would normally use it on a job.
  - There may be a charge in the Batteries to test your unit, but we recommend that you charge it before your first use. (Shipped with a Charge)
